The seminar...

This whole day seminar is intended to help teachers prepare a significant and effective program in what is perhaps the most deeply personal of all subjects in the basic education curriculum. Education in Sexuality is not just an academic matter—it is a life-directing learning program since what is primarily studied is human relationship between man and woman, between husband and wife, between father and mother. Its teaching, as such, has to be based on objective and universal principles that ought to be more or less commonly understood by the students, parents and teachers across the grade levels. The teaching of sexuality has to be age-appropriate both in substance and form, content and approach.

“Given the extremely critical significance of the content and pedagogy of education in human sexuality, which could very well influence or determine the direction of the student’s present and future life and standing in society, the teachers are expected to have a firm grasp of the basic principles of character and character (values) education and their nuances.

The essential pedagogical element that should be targeted is clarity and coherence among concepts and across related messages (and, by implication, across grade levels and teachers) in order to provide the student with a stable framework for their personal and individual application to their current life via day-to-day and big decision-making.”
